

Asylkreis launches new initiative to help asylum seekers

The first meeting of the new idea floated by Mrs Claudia Schaffner-Kalz of Asylkreis to introduce a new platform from where they can reach out to all those who may be in need of help.

The new platform is named as 'Club Asyl' and on Thursday evening was the first meeting where Mrs Claudia spoke her mind out, leaving her seat to approach others in different seats on the long table laid out for the participants who turned up for the introductory meeting and explained the objectives to them individually also.

"This new platform or the Club as we call it, is being launched to reach out to the foreigners who have sought asylum in Germany and have already been granted citizenship rights but are still facing problems for integration. At the same time the members of the Club are willing to extend all possible help and assistance to those who are still struggling through various stages of the process of asylum procedures," Mrs Claudia explained.

"There is no prejudice towards anybody and members of our Club are open to listen to anybody who has something to say and we all are too eager to extend whatever help and assistance we can offer to them to solve or mitigate their problems and issues," she added.

There were 18 participants who turned up for the introductory meeting of the Club and the beauty of the event was that there were at least 6 foreign nationals from Syria, Afghanistan, Pakistan and the USA present at the table.

"In the past we have launched some other endeavors also in which we provided asylum-seekers from different nationalities in Germany to come together, interact, speak their minds out and share their problems. In the past also such events have helped us understand the issues those people were facing and did whatever was possible to solve their problems and issues," Mrs Claudia said.

"We hope that this new initiative that we have come up with will take us even further in our efforts to be helpful to those who need us here," she concluded.

Mr Uwe Kalz also took the opportunity to push his initiative, 'Hilfsangebot "Ausbildung und Arbeit"' under which he is offering help to prepare the job-seekers through a 7-point preparatory process that include how they can: 'find a job offer and apply; Start Searching - This is how they can find job offers; We will support you in the current application process; What is the content of a job advertisement; How do they create a CV and in application (digital and analogue); How to prepare for a job interview and How can they present their qualifications.

The event, hosted at a lovely restaurant `Wunderbar Weite Welt` was attended by Elfie Helmling, Uwe Kalz, Magdalene Pitthan besides other members.
